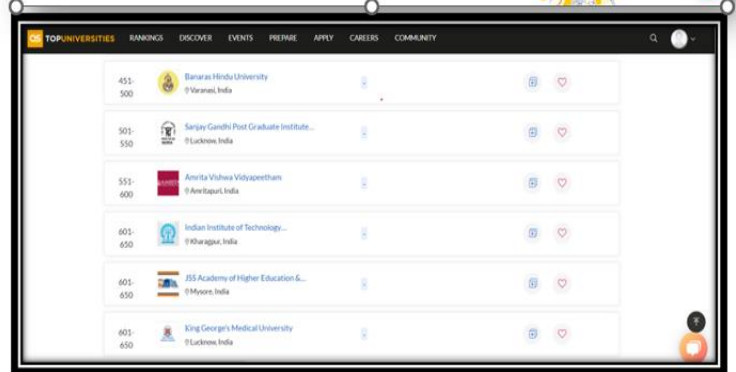
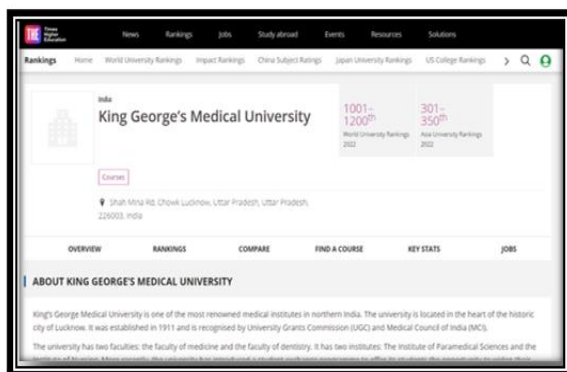
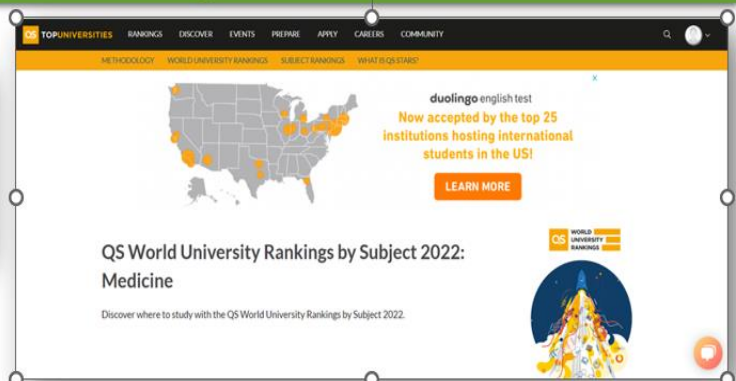
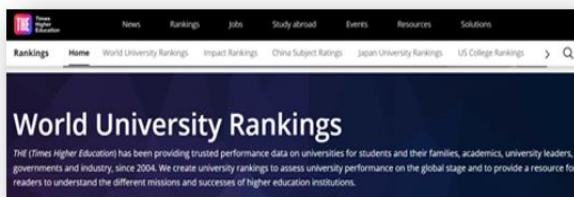


PARTICIPATION IN WORLD AND NATIONAL RANKINGS AND ACCREDITATION

University started participating for various rankings and accreditation processes since the last accreditation cycle of NAAC in 2017. As a part of IQAC, Deanship of Quality and Future planning was entrusted to submit University's credentials for various Government and non-government platforms in collaboration with IT Cell. We participated in the NIRF ranking process in various categories conducted by MHRD from 2018 onwards. The university was ranked consistently within top 10 medical institutes of the country by India Today and Outlook Groups. THE (Times Higher Education Rankings) and QS ranking results motivated us to improve our efforts for global benchmarks in education. Similarly, a lot of effort is visible for providing and maintaining quality laboratory services in pathology and microbiology. All labs are now NABL accredited. The process of participation in such external auditing helps us to identify gaps and to develop strategy for improvements.

DEVELOPMENT, IMPLEMENTATION AND ANALYSIS OF FEEDBACK PROCESS

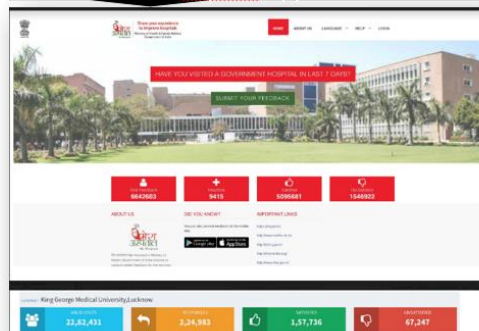
One of the priority areas of Internal Quality Assurance Cell of the University is the development of self-sustainable mechanism for designing, distribution, collection and analysis of feedback on various quality Indicators from students, parents, examiners, patients, alumni and employers. During last 5 years, a systematic approach has been developed for execution of feedback process in our university. Through proper research, standard questionnaires were developed for assessing quality of teachers, course and curriculum delivery (SSS), examiner's opinion about assessment process, hostel facility, alumni etc. A committee was constituted to validate the questionnaires. After thorough approval, google form links were generated from dean QP mail ID and a system was developed for proper distribution of links and messages to all possible stakeholders. Students are communicated for providing periodic feedback by serving notices batchwise via WhatsApp group and also through notice boards. At several Places QR codes for collecting feedbacks are placed in the Kalam centre and Indoor Ward premises. Responses of various feedbacks are categorized and tabulated at Dean QP office and an anonymous analysis report (GAP ANALYSIS & RECOMMENDATIONS) is prepared and is communicated to an appropriate authority for reflections and developing action plan to improve various indices. After a gap of certain period, respective in-charges are requested to present their action taken report.

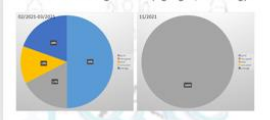

To build the quality culture and develop awareness for various benchmarks by self-assessment and evaluation, IQAC started a ranking contest for “Best Department Award” in 2020. It was decided to felicitate departments with highest scores on an annual event, “Foundation Day” celebrations of the University. A 20-point assessment format was prepared including various parameters in teaching-learning, research, awards, peer perception etc. Each point was given weightages and credits with a total score of 100 points. Depending on specific roles, all departments were categorized under 4 broad heads viz. Pre and Paraclinical, Broad Specialities, Super speciality and Dental Sciences departments. Many departments participated with enthusiasm. It was heartening to receive feedback from few departments that “they must work specifically in certain parameters to improve their ranking”. Award ceremony acted as catalyst and the effects were clearly seen in the responses for 2021 competition.

DEVELOPMENT AND TRIAL OF FAS (FACULTY APPRAISAL SOFTWARE)

Collecting information/data from various offices, departments, units and individual faculty member and compilation for submitting it at various platforms as per specific requirements is an extremely challenging task. As a result, an effort was initiated to develop a faculty portal (2019). Each level user/administrator was provided with a unique ID and password. Two levels of data entry access (Faculty and HOD) and multiple level administrator (HOD/Deans) access was granted. Feasibility dry run and trial was done at multiple times. 10% of the total users responded. The system did not turn up as a success story due to issues like multiple extensive entries and dependency on third party for data retrieval. At a point of time, it was realized that the investment in terms of time and content development is not as per our expectations. Therefore, it was resolved to build a new mobile based, more user friendly application for information retrieval.

The Intent Of The Quality Policy

In pursuance of the provisions of clause (3) of Article 348. of the constitution, by notification no-2682/71-2-1 I-CMU/6/03, dated 29 July 2011, all activities of the University are abode by rules and regulations set under its Act and Statutes and this policy document delineates the commitment and processes to build a quality culture among its all stakeholders.

- Set quality objectives and plans to implement this quality policy, and seek to achieve continual

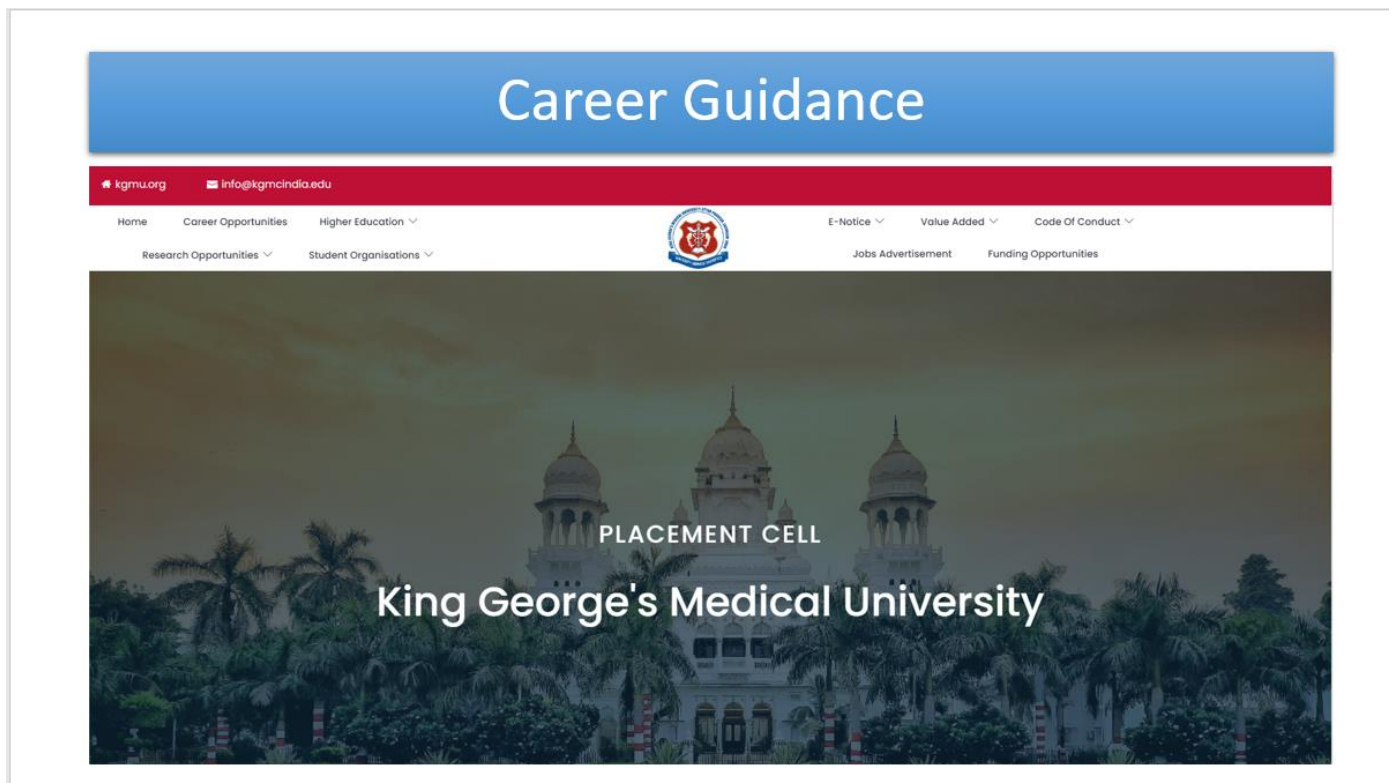

CODING OF ALL PROGRAMS AND COURSES OF THE UNIVERSITY

University was following a unique coding system for providing enrolment numbers of students for various programs and courses and also a system of paper codes. A need was raised for developing specific program codes as per requirement by NAAC. A committee comprising deans of various faculty, controller of examination and dean QP developed a 6 unit ALPHANUMERIC coding system for various programs and courses. First alphabet of letter King (K) and George's(G) Medical University, were picked to specify courses run by KGMU. For next two alphabets of the code, abbreviation of all programs were written in capital letters. Next two alphabets are specific to program like for MBBS, first two letters are selected for code. Hence for MBBS program, alpha code is KGMB. Subsequently, two digits (numerals) are placed as postfixed part of the code. Each subject of the program is then arranged in ascending alphabetical order (A-Z) and then each subject has been given a unique number beginning from 1. So, the course code for the subject of anatomy is KGMB01.

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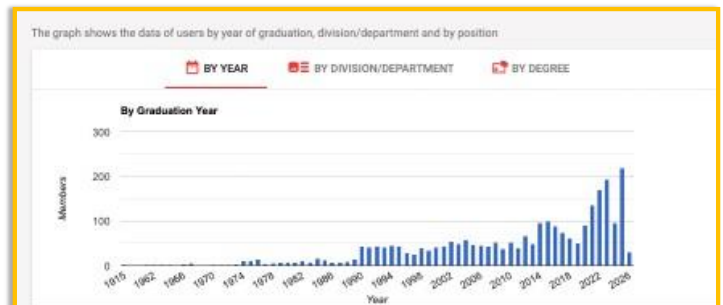


STRENGTHENING NETWORKING WITH GEORGIANS

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


GLOBAL EXPECTATIONS AND NATIONS VISION AND MISSION: SENSITIZATION SESSIONS




Sustainable Development Goals Sensitization

Sensitization for NAAC accreditation Process for Affiliated Colleges





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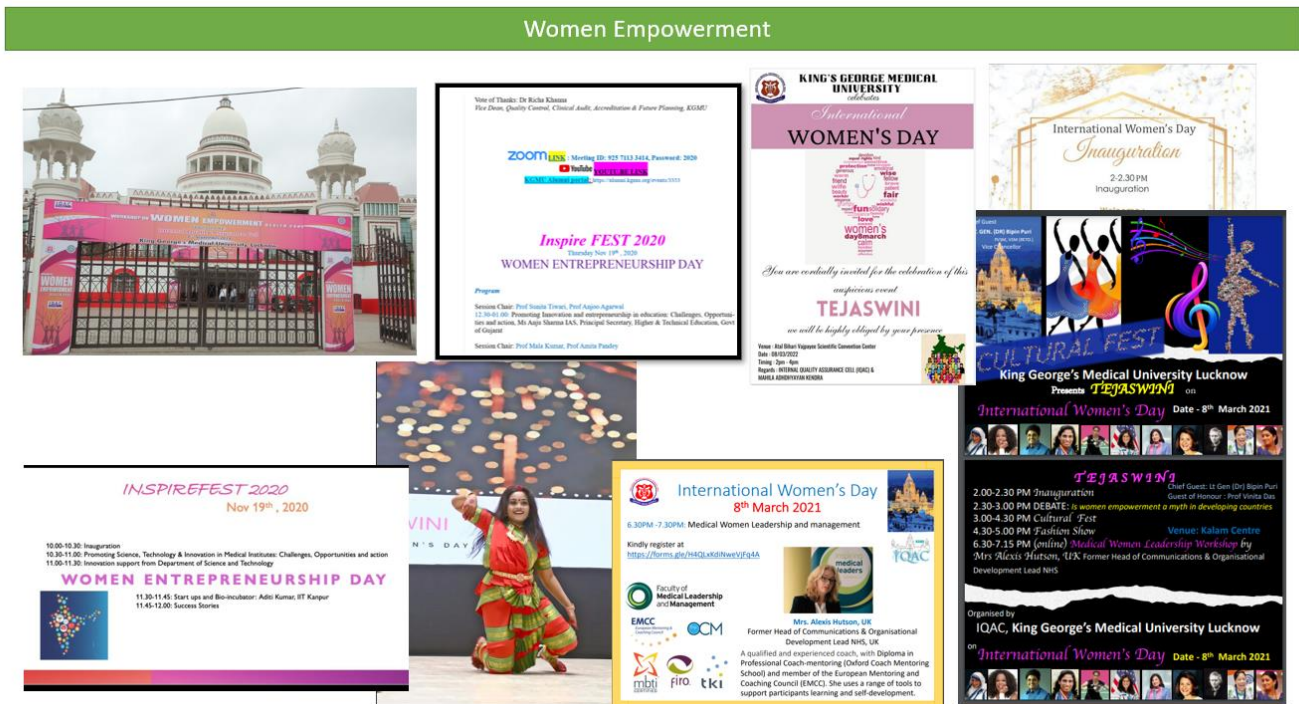


WOMEN EMPOWERMENT DRIVES BY IQAC

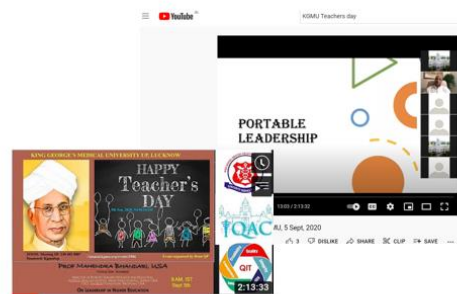
