Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing Course

Rules & Regulations

- 1. This is the 2nd examination for entrance to Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing course, due to non fulfillment of seats providing students an opportunity to pursue the course. Application form shall be available on the website (www.kgmu.org) from 12th July, 2013.
- 2. Admission to Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing Course in the following Nursing Colleges, which are affiliated to the University, will be made on the basis of entrance examination scheduled to be held on Monday 12th August, 2013.

B.C.M. College of Nursing, Khairabad, Sitapur.

- 3. The selection of the candidates will be strictly based on the merit of the entrance examination and preference of the college given by candidate.
- 4. Minimum qualifications for admission is candidate should have pass GNM Course.
- 5. Candidates should be a Registered Nurse & Midwife.
- 6. Duration of Course is two years.
- 7. Only females are eligible as submitted by the aforesaid college.
- 8. Candidates must be medically fit. Additional medical check up may done before admission (the candidates who are in the merit list are required to submit certificate of physical fitness from registered medical practioner).
- 9. Candidates for the entrance test will have to deposit a fee of **Rs. 1500/- (Rs. 1200/- for SC/ST)** through Bank Draft/Banker's Cheque payable to the **Controller of Examinations, K.G. Medical University, U.P., Lucknow,** along with the prescribed application form duly filled in.
- 10. No T.A./D.A. will be paid for attending the Entrance Examination/Interview/Counseling.
- 11. Implementation of changes in regard to admission process/selection criteria etc. will be incorporated as per INC notification issued from time to time.
- 12. The decision of the Vice-Chancellor shall be final in the matter of selection of candidates for admission to the course and no appeal shall be entertained on this subject.
- 13. Any dispute in regard to any matter referred to herewith shall be subject to the jurisdiction of Allahabad High Court of Judicature, Lucknow Bench only.
- 14. There is no provision for rechecking of answer sheets or communication of marks obtained at the entrance examination. Result of the entrance shall be available at the website of the University.

- 15. **Distribution of the seats:-** Category wise distribution of seats will be as per UP Public Service Commission Scheduled Caste, Schedule tribes and other Backward Class Reservation amendment ordinance 2002.
- 16. Seats may be increased or decreased at the time of counseling on the directives of the hon'ble Vice Chancellor, K.G. Medical University, U.P., Lucknow.
- 17. In the event of more than one candidate securing same marks, the merit will be decided on the basis of highest marks obtained by the candidate in the examination as per the following order: i) Higher marks in GNM, ii) Higher percentage in Intermediate.

18. Counseling Procedure:-

- i. Counseling shall be held at K.G. Medical University, U.P., Lucknow on 20th August, 2013.
- ii. A non refundable fee of Rs. 300/- will have to be submitted through Bank Draft in favour of 'Controller of Examinations' payable at Lucknow.
- iii. A separate Bank Draft of Rs. 5,000/- in favour of controller of Examination, payable at Lucknow shall have to be deposited by the candidates at the time of counseling, on award of seat.
- iv. The Bank Draft of Rs. 5,000/- shall be returned to candidate on his/her joining of any one of Nursing Courses. However, if the candidate opts for seat and does not join then University has the right to forfeit that money.
