



**Memorandum of Understanding  
between  
King George's Medical University, Lucknow  
&  
CSIR-CIMAP, Lucknow**



Representatives of King George's Medical University and CSIR-CIMAP have discussed the desirability and feasibility of an interactive relationship designed to strengthen the bonds between the two institutions. This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is intended to facilitate inter-institutional visits as described in the objective listed below. Both King George's Medical University & CSIR-CIMAP are also referred to herein as "Institution" or, Collectively, Institutions.

I.

**Objectives:**

1. To promote the visits of faculty in programs for the mutual benefits of both institutions.
2. To promote the visits of students in programs for the mutual benefit of both institutions.
3. To foster collaboration in teaching, research, and development.
4. To support the visits of academic materials and publications.
5. To facilitate the cultural and intellectual enrichment opportunities for the faculty and students of both institutions.
6. To facilitate working together of faculty on various Herbal products in Indian traditional systems and to develop newer treatment modalities in various diseases.

II.

**Operation:**

1. Prior to actual visits or collaboration, the institutions will negotiate and sign a Program Agreement setting forth the specific obligations and responsibilities to carry out any of the following:
  - a. Faculty visits,
  - b. Student visits,
  - c. Visits of academic materials,
  - d. Collaborative research, and
  - e. Educational program.
2. The Institutions will explore ways and means to finance joint projects through special government and other funding sources. This MOU is not intended, and shall not be interpreted, to offer any kind or form of financial support or consideration.

III.

**Term:**

This memorandum of understanding shall be effective for a period of three (3) years from the last date of approval by the appropriate authorities of both institutions. Pending appropriate review, this MOU may be extended for an additional three (3) years with written consent of both institutions.

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IV.

Termination:

Either institutions may terminate this MOU at any time without cause by giving three (3) months written notice to the other. Upon termination the provisions of this MOU and corresponding program Agreements shall continue to apply to ongoing activities until each is complete, up to a maximum of one (1) year from the effective date of termination.

V.

Language

This MOU is prepared in English and may also be prepared in a language as requested by King George's Medical University & CSIR-CIMAP Lucknow. In the event of an inconsistency the English version shall apply and be binding on CSIR-CIMAP and King George's Medical University.

VI.

Warranty Authority:

The person(s) executing this agreement on behalf of the institutions represent and warrant that each has been duly authorized to execute this Memorandum of Understanding on behalf of the institution and to validly and legally bind the institution to all of its terms, performances, and provisions.

Neither Institution shall have the authority to represent or otherwise bind the other institution, nor shall any of their respective agents, employees or representatives be construed to be the agent, employee or representative of the other.
