- When we introspect why very few universities make place in top positions of world

rankings, there are several reasons:

1. Citations are mostly done for publications from the west, who don't vote us for

our increased perception.

2. There is less international collaboration in publications

3. International Collaboration in publications is focused for few high repute

universities of the West, others from Asia or other parts of the world are ignored.

(This is called International Research Network)

4. We don't give votes to our own State Universities

5. We don't collaborate with Universities from underdeveloped countries

6. There is limited reach to our alumni for placement and perception

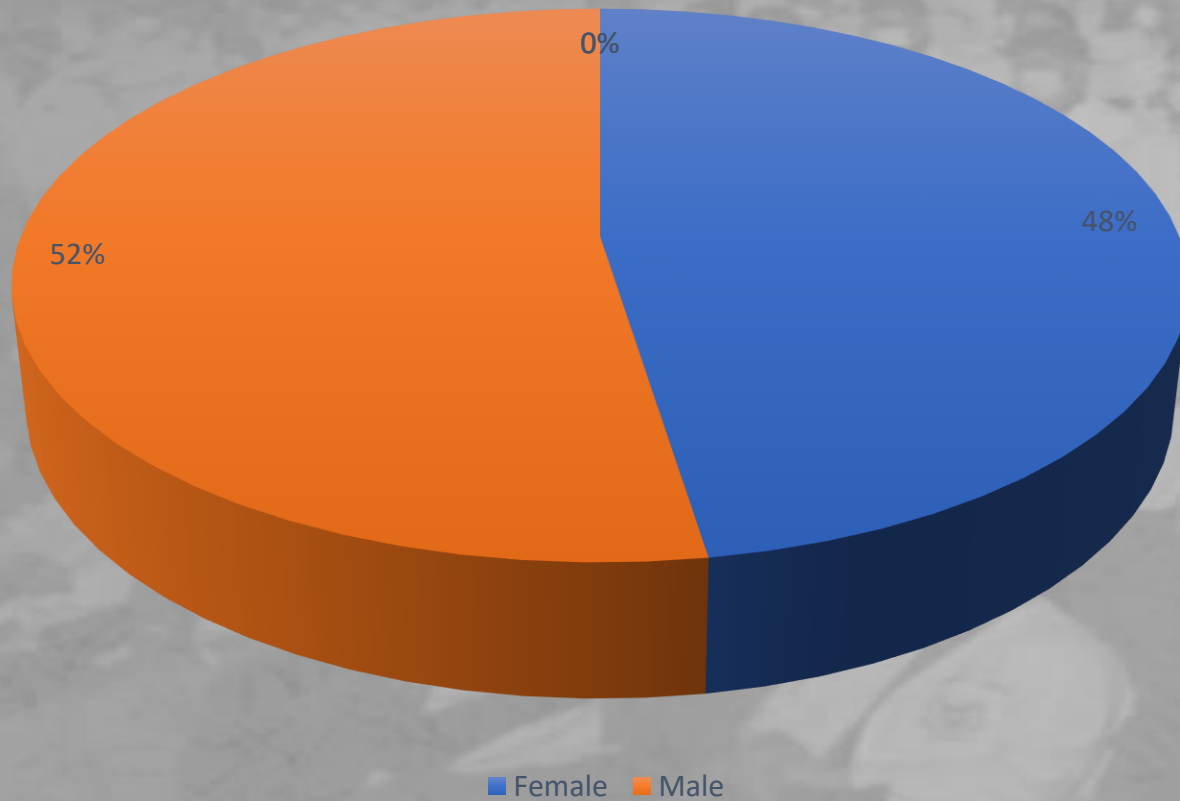

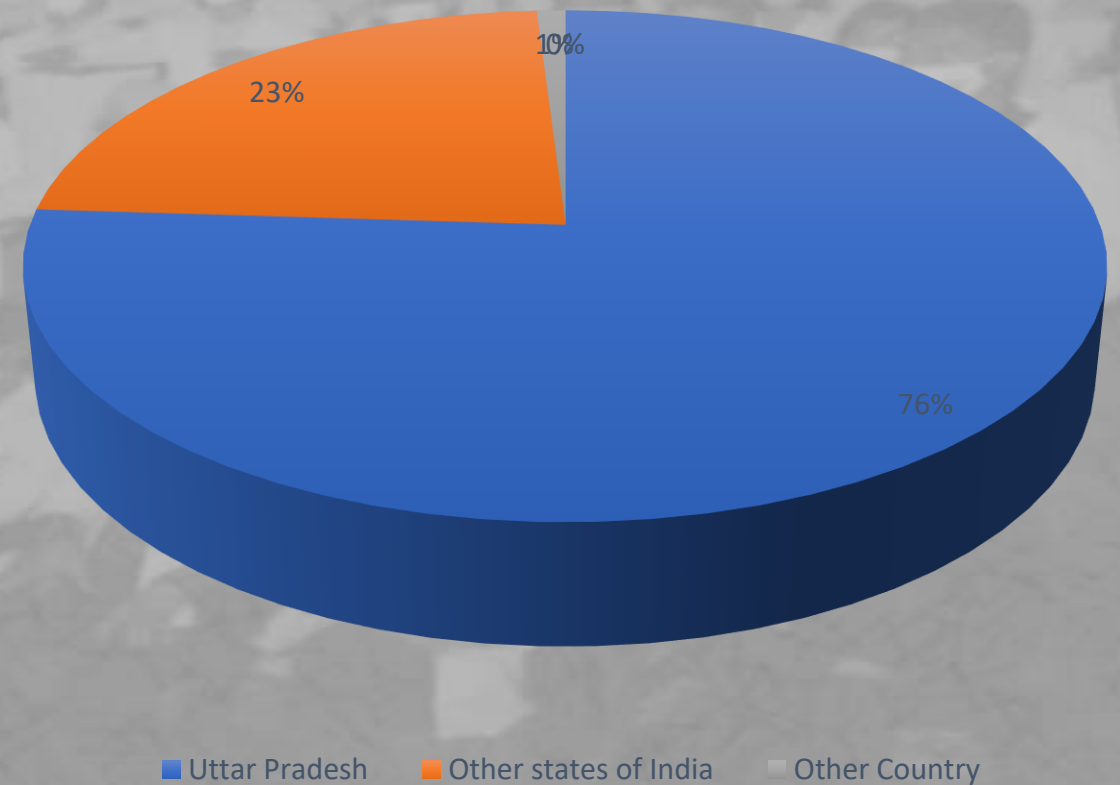

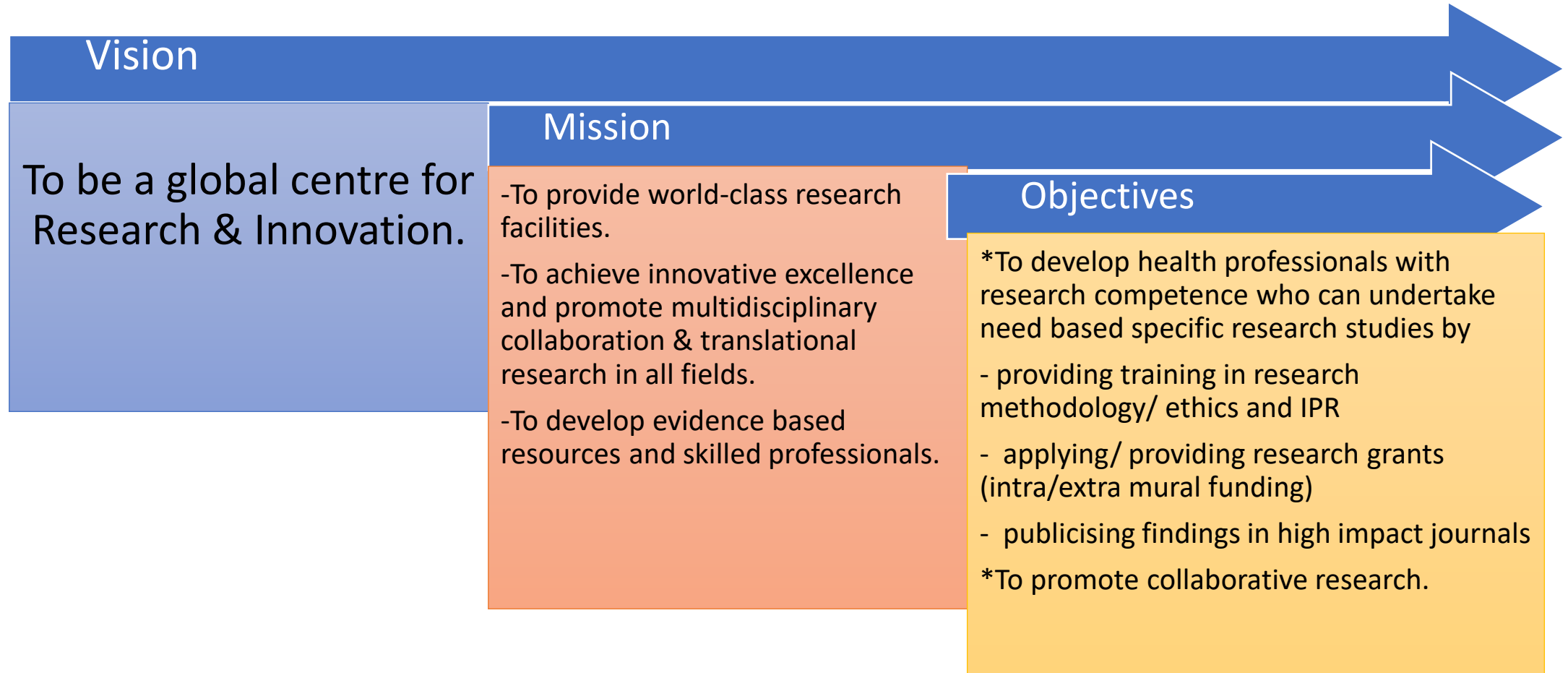

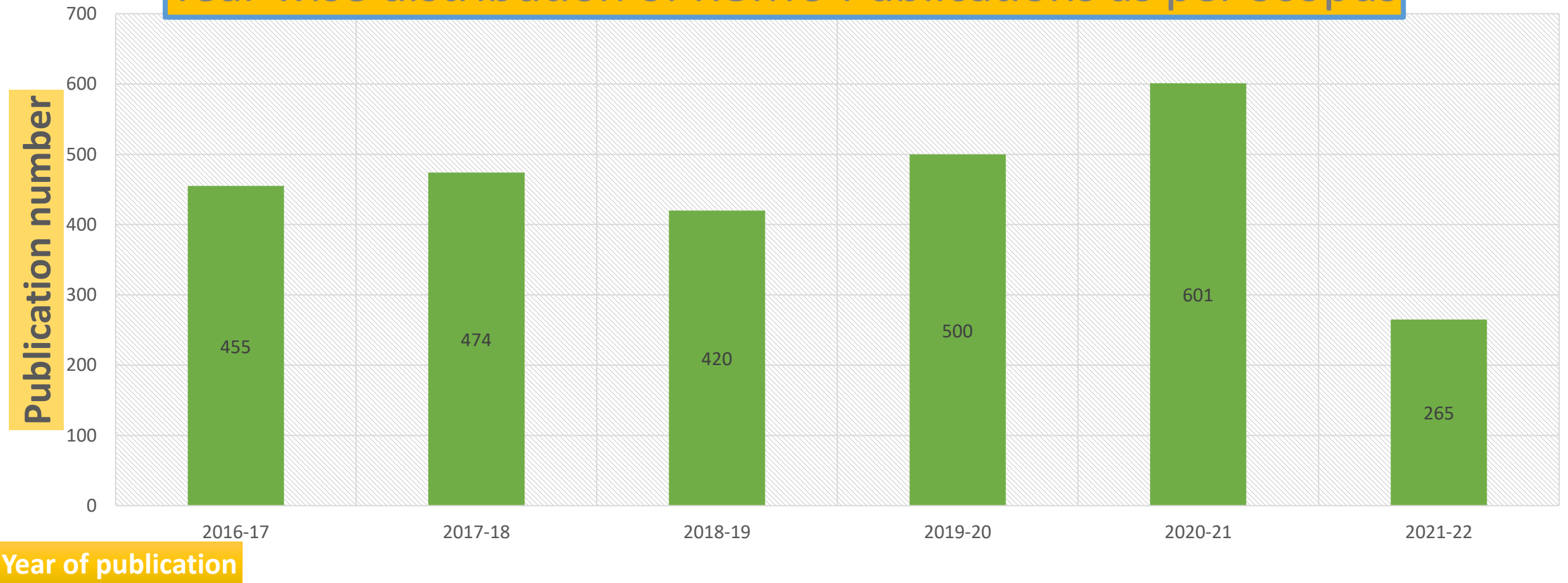

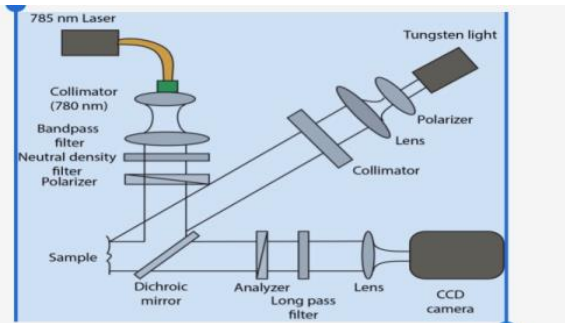
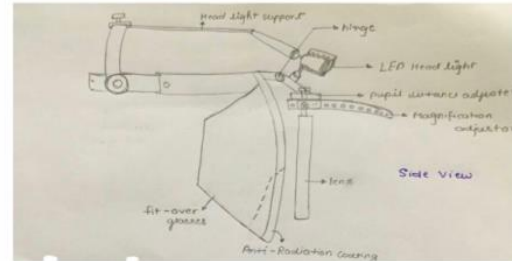
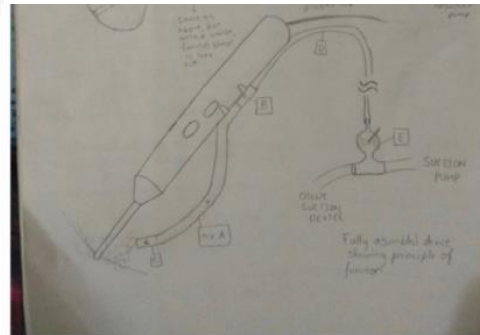


Figure 4. Schematic representation of NIR camera (adapted from Opt Express, 2010 Nov 8;18(23):24293-300).

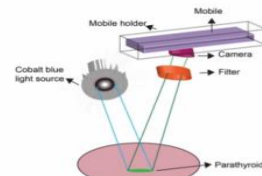


Figure 1. Schematic representation of fluorescein dye stained parathyroid gland identification using mobile camera fitted with filter.

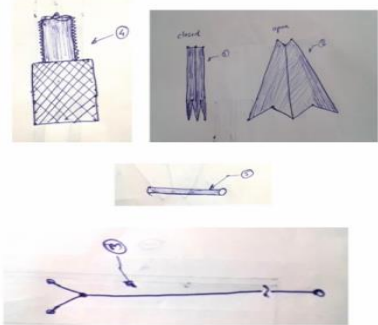
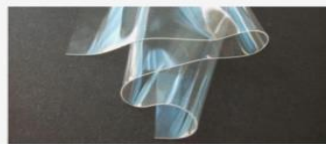
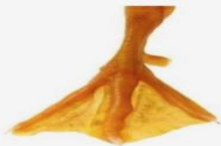


Figure 1: Inspiration from nature

Evidence of Success

Kayakalp award : KGMU won the second award under the Kayakalp scheme of government in the year 2017

Giving special recognition to KGMU for the Biomedical waste management practices it was made the nodal centre for providing state level trainings on BMWM and infection control to all the quality managers from various districts of UP approximately 565 doctors received training in 20 sessions in the year 2021-2022.

An international conference was organized by KGMU on BMWM in the year 2018, which was duly attended by international faculty Dr Ruth Stringer, Dr Suzan both from Switzerland and Dr Megha Rathi from WHO, Geneva

BMWM and energy conservation practices at KGMU were projected as a case study by Health care without harm in the year 2019.

Waste management during Covid Pandemic at KGMU was given special recognition in the WHO bulletin this year

...solving the waste problem.”
Many hospitals have been implementing waste segregation for some time. For example, in King George’s Medical University (KGMU), a 4000-bed hospital in Lucknow, India, colour-coded waste bags and bins are used. Each bin is collected and taken to a centralized receptacle of the corresponding colour, except for the waste in yellow infectious waste bags, which is taken to an incinerator located away from the hospital.

According to Professor Kirti Srivastava, a radiation oncologist, and head of the environment department which oversees biomedical waste management and pest control at KGMU, 90% of the hospital’s waste is non-infectious.

“Black bag general waste is taken away to landfill by the municipal authorities. Blue bag waste (metal and glass waste), white (sharps) and red (blood) waste, bottles, catheters and urine containers are being steam-sterilized

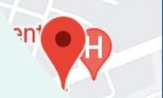
Democratically. They found that autoclaving is not always achieved. Autoclaving produces carcinogenic dioxins and furans. They found that despite the upfront investment, the cost-savings over the long term are not as high as expected. Autoclaved waste could be handled at a lower rate by local waste management companies. According to Lokesh, the government has taken the decision of phasing out incinerators and investing in 70 autoclaves to handle infectious and sharp waste.

For WHO’s Montgomerie, the pandemic may have exposed issues in the way we generate waste, it is also providing an opportunity to explore innovations in waste management equipment and practices.

Inaugural address was given by Hon'ble Chancellor Uttar Pradesh, Smt. Anandiben Patel Ji. Prof. S.P. Thyagarajan, Chancellor, Dr. S. Kowsalya, Registrar, Dr. Bharathi Harishankar, Vice Chancellor, Dr. U. Jerinabi, IQAC Coordinator from AVINUT were present during the function. Function was marked by a book release and award ceremony of meritorious students.



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India is now charged with new mission for becoming a soft power at the global platform. The way passes through young minds. Therefore, it is the responsibility of higher education institutions to bring necessary changes in existing system which is more knowledge acquiring instead of problem solving. Two important guidelines were discussed in brief, firstly, aligning with SDG 2040 and secondly, NEP 2020. The webinar, was focused around, sharing best practices in all 7 domains of the quality.

Key Note Address on “Path towards SDG “was delivered by Prof. S.P. Thyagarajan, Chancellor, AVINUTY. For us important takeaways are

1. Higher Education institutional Goals must be aligned with local, national and global needs.
2. Institutions must frame their own goals and set realistic milestones to achieve the same. Careful preparation of benchmarks should be the first step to start with.
3. Institutions must try to gain higher national and global rankings and accreditations
4. Technology must be integrated in all disciplines
5. Institution must strive for creating state of art centre of excellence
6. Must showcase strengths of the university
7. Must improve national and international collaborations (SDG17)
8. Promotion of online learning, e content development and provide MOOCs
9. Establish Village model : shared success model story of a tribal village with unemployability converted in to a self sustained model for utilization of every drop of local flora of amla, tamarind and millet.

Special address on “Implementation of NEP in AVINUTY “ was delivered by Dr. Bharathi Harishankar, Vice Chancellor, AVINUTY .

She stressed that NEP 2020 is to achieve and ensure inclusive and equitable education along with providing life long opportunity for all. NEP focuses on access of higher education for all who want it. It is about making the higher education portable, accountable and affordable with quality. To ensure implementation of NEP, they have created 20 committees looking after its various domains like ensuring implementation of academic bank of credits, multiple exit and entrances etc. They have adopted 20 villages and are helping in implementing government programs to uplift the quality of life of villages. She highlighted that adoption of NEP is helpful in introspection in relation to institutional strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and challenges. She quoted Hon'ble Prime Ministers statement that “ Mind is never a



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problem but it is Mindset which creates troubles” and NEP helps in building a positive mindset. She said that let us make our society a better place to live by sharing knowledge.

Best Practice in Curricular Aspects was discussed by Dr. G. Padmavathy, Dean of Academics on Multidisciplinary Approach to Curriculum Development

Best Practice in the domain of Teaching-Learning and Evaluation T”echnology Enriched Teaching-Learning” was shared by Process Dr. K. Arockia Maraichelvi, Associate Professor, Human Development.

Best Practice – Research, Innovations, and Extension Quality Enhancement through R&D and Community Innovation among Students by Dr. P. Lalitha, Dean, Research and Development, AVINUTY

The presentation highlighted the University’s R&D policy planning towards alignment of NEP 2020. It highlighted that through this policy they are moving towards Atma Nirbha r Bharat vision of NEP 2020. They had formulated guidelines for research keeping this vision in mind. Besides, work shop and hanholding for faculty nad students is done to promote research. They focus on collaborative research projects and havea mentoring consortium. Students reaserch is vetted through stringent quqlity check and they train the students for the same with adequate infrastructure to so so. They also presented a video of DR CNR Rao research centre with state of the art armamentarium. Yearly research convention is organized to showcase nad motivate research environment in the University. They are registered with KAPILA portal for facilitation of Patents. They also showed a video on pavers brick which is thgeir patented technology. They are also generating revenue through consultancy and are implementing incentive based capacity building. An example of facebook post was shown. Thae they have e campus software to document reaserch.

A unique Gurudaksham program from donation by a superannuated faculty has promoted reaserch grants for students. The presentation was ended by the adage” we rise by lifting others”.

Best Practice – Infrastructure and Learning Resources A Model, Modern Learning Management System Dr. P. Subhashini, Professor, Computer Science, AVINUTY

The presenation showed that the University possess basic knowledge and relative tools for learning. They have their own cloud centre which provides unlimited storage for faculty nad students and also act as a service provider. The presentation focused on the in house development of LMS for teaching learning purpose. In 2019 they got a grant from DST which helped them in development of the LMS. Initially the sensitization was done through google classrooms during Covid time. Then they moved to E campus Moodle and in third stage developed in house LMS which is functional in 2022. The future plans are to develop an open source LMS platform.



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Best Practice – Student Support and Progression Dedicated Student's Counseling and Psychological Support Centre Dr. Sudha, Asst. Professor, Psychology, AVINUTY

Dedicated student counseling and psychological support center was presented by Dr. Sudha from the Department of Psychology who highlighted that the department since its inception has been providing counseling services and now does it as a Center for Ambitious and Resourceful Endeavors (C.A.R.E) where they enhance the mental health and well-being of students along with skill based and holistic development. The center offers Psychometric assessment and interventions to staff and students in form of behavior therapy to make them emotionally independent. Peer counseling is advocated. An important aspect of career guidance and building is aptitude testing of all final students. The University has developed and validated a CARE Intervention module and CARE Assessment module which encompasses compassion, achieving a purposeful life, relationship building and enhancing positive emotions.

Best Practice – Governance, Leadership, and Management Academic and Administrative Audit as a tool for Institutional Quality Enhancement, Dr. U. Jerinabi, Coordinator, IQAC, AVINUTY

Dr Jerinabi explained that the adoption of academic and administrative audits helped the institute in gaining better ranking and accreditation. She emphasised that AAA helps to understand and assesses strengths and weaknesses of departments and administrative units. It helps in identifying bottlenecks and gaps, better management of resources and their mobilization. At their institute the audits are aligned with quality markers set by accreditation council.

Best Practice – Institutional Values and Best Practices Inculcation of Value Based Education & Life Skills Dr. K. Ramya, Asst. Professor, Business Administration, AVINUTY

The Institute distinctiveness was discussed by Dr. Ramiya, Institutional values and best practices: Inculcation of Value based Education and Life skills. The vision of the institution was highlighted as it is a women university imparting value system to women while helping them in self-development and empowerment. The approach is to sensitize students to positive values and inculcate them in a class by engaging students in practicing positive values and attitudes by acting on imbibed values. The community service and other extension services help students develop positive values and attitudes both in and outside the class room. They also offer a community based value system by active participation. Through these extracurricular activities and daily routines the value education is addressed for all domains of learning. Bonding between Institution and Alumni is also cultivated. Bioethics in the form of specific domain based values like consumer ethics, research ethics is done in the regular courses and in the value added courses through



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ethical thinking, anticorruption, cyber crime, human rights and gender education to name a few. The value inculcation begins as soon as the student is admitted in any course and through her stay the various activities are planned in a manner to give value based education and to make the University a center for arts, culture and heritage, keeping in line with the NEP vision2040.

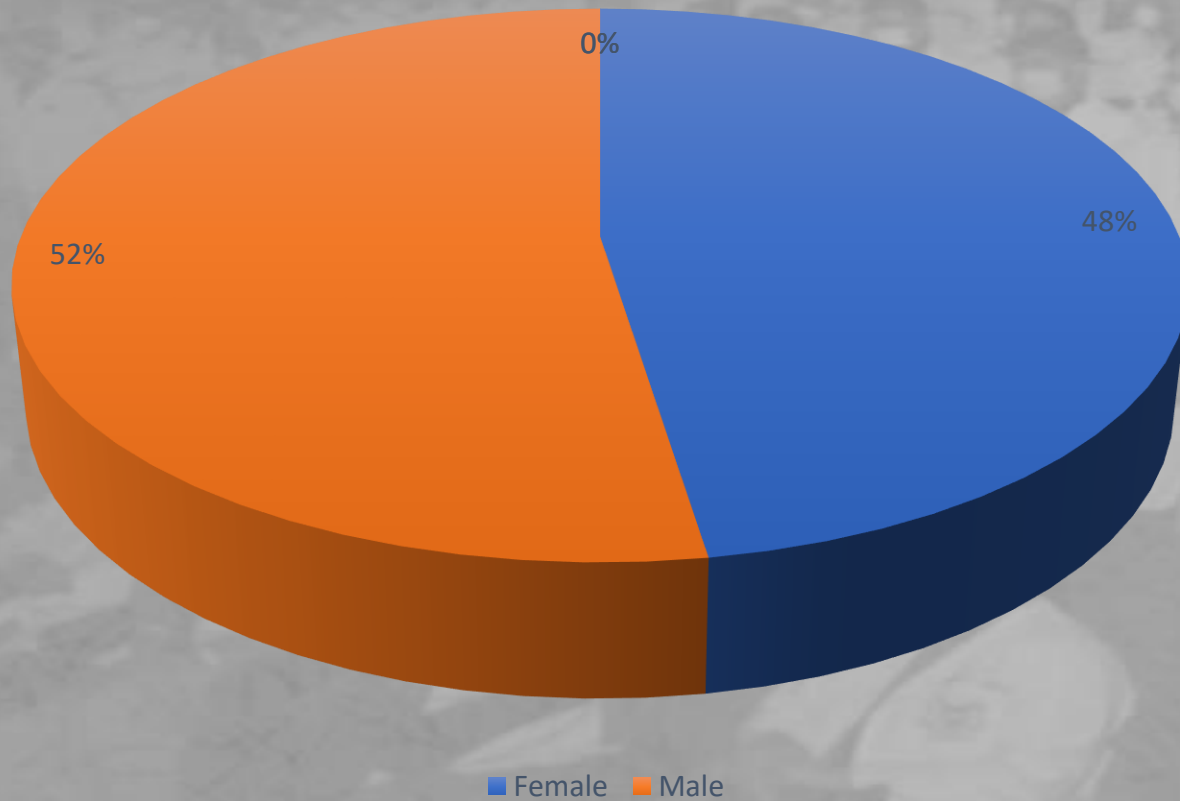

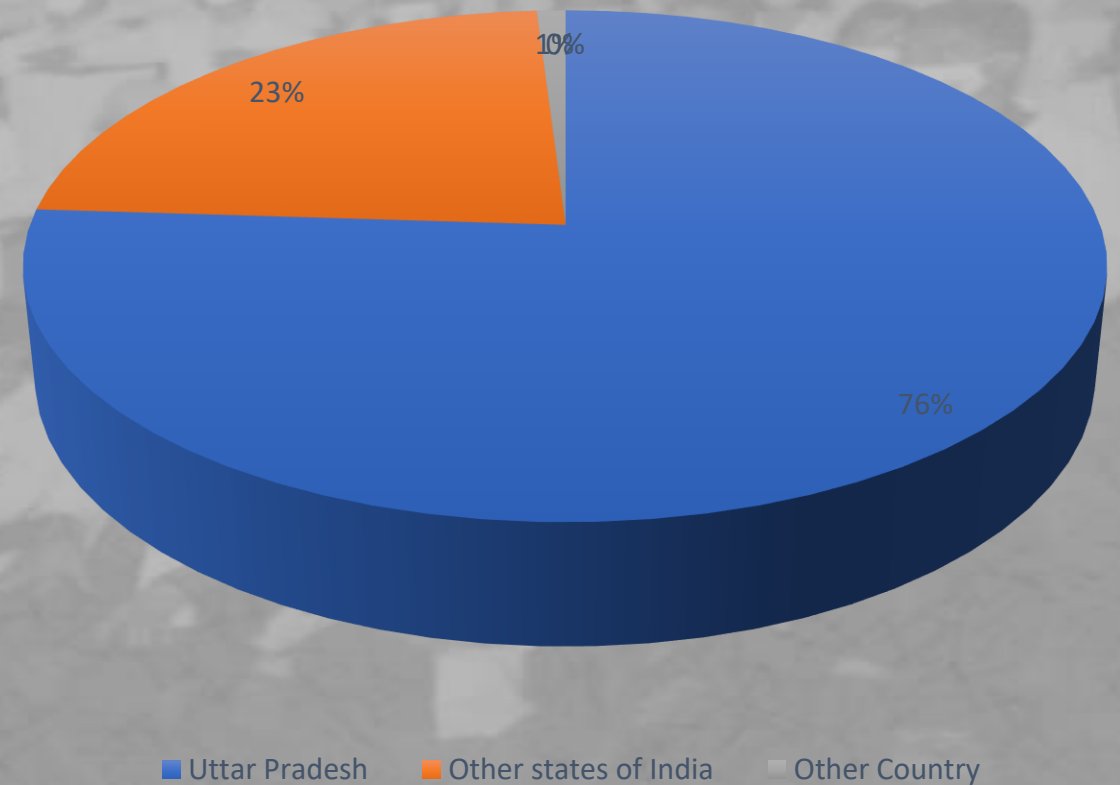
