

- (iii) Member - A person well-versed with anti plagiarism tools, to be nominated by the Head of the Department

As part of zero tolerance towards plagiarism and University Grants Commission notification "University Grants Commission (Promotion Of Academic Integrity And Prevention Of Plagiarism In Higher Educational Institutions) Regulations, 2018" dated 23rd July, 2018 for Detection/Reporting/Handling of Plagiarism, it is required that an Institutional Academic Integrity Panel (IAIP) at the Institutional level and respective Departmental Academic Integrity Panel/s (DAIP) at the departmental level be formed.

If any member of the academic community suspects with appropriate proof that a case of plagiarism has happened in any document, he or she shall report it to the Departmental Academic Integrity Panel (DAIP). Upon receipt of such a complaint or allegation the DAIP shall investigate the matter and submit its recommendations to the Institutional Academic Integrity Panel (IAIP) of the University. The authorities of University can also take suo motu notice of an act of plagiarism and initiate proceedings under these regulations. Similarly, proceedings can also be initiated by the University on the basis of findings of an examiner. All such cases will be investigated by the IAIP.

The composition of Institutional Academic Integrity Panel (IAIP) shall be as given below:

- (i) Chairman – Dean, Academics
- (ii) Member - Senior Academician other than Chairman, to be nominated by Hon'ble Vice Chancellor *Prof RK Jang*
- (iii) Member - One member nominated from outside the University by Hon'ble Vice Chancellor *Dr Ritu Karoli, RMLIMS (Sub Dean Research)*
- (iv) Member - A person well versed with anti-plagiarism tools, to be nominated by Hon'ble Vice Chancellor *Prof Amita Jain*

Similarly, Departmental Academic Integrity Panel (DAIP) shall be formed in all the departments; for this Heads of Departments may be asked to form the DAIP. The composition of Departmental Academic Integrity Panel (DAIP) shall be as given below:

- (i) Chairman - Head of the Department
- (ii) Member - Senior academician from outside the department, to be nominated by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor
- (iii) Member - A person well versed with anti plagiarism tools. to be nominated by the Head of the Department
