**MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL
OF KING GEORGE'S MEDICAL UNIVERSITY, LUCKNOW,
HELD ON 04.08.2026**

A special meeting of the Executive Council of King George's Medical University, Lucknow was held on 04th August, 2026 in the Board Room of Administrative Block, KGMU, Lucknow at 4.00 P.M.

Members present in the meeting were as in Annexure No. 1.

Dr. Udai Bhan Singh, Chancellor's Nominee & Dr. A. Kumar joined the meeting through video conferencing.

Deliberations of the meeting and decisions taken were as under:

1.	Compliance of the Judgement dated 15.07.2026 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Allahabad, Lucknow Bench in Writ A No. 5845 of 2020 : Dr. Kaleshwar Prasad Singh versus King George's Medical University, Lucknow through Registrar and another Executive Council was informed that Dr. Kaleshwar Prasad Singh was working as Associate Professor in the Department of Microbiology, King George's Medical University, Lucknow. CPMT examination 2014 was conducted by King George Medical University, Lucknow and Prof. A.K. Singh Head of the Department of Plastic Surgery was	Executive Council deliberated on the matter and after due deliberation decided as under: 1. Order of the Hon'ble High Court dated 15.07.2026 should be challenged before the appropriate/competent forum/court to protect the decision and interest of the University. 2. If necessary, a Senior Advocate be engaged in the matter for

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appointed as the Controller of Examination by the University Administration. Mr. Pankaj Saxena lodged FIR No. 486 of 2014 U/s 420, 406, 467, 468, 471 of IPC at Police Station Chowk, Lucknow against Rahul Gupta, Smt Kumkum Gupta with the allegation that he was cheated by the aforesaid persons by taking an amount of Rs.18,35,000/- in the chamber of Dr. D.K. Katiyar, Professor. Thereafter FIR No.1460 of 2014 U/s 420, 406, 419,420, 467, 468 & 471 of IPC at Police Station Sector 20 NOIDA was also lodged by Dinesh Chand Purohit. Further FIR No. 568 of 2014 U/s 420 of IPC at Police Station, Chowk, Lucknow was lodged by Hemant Tripathi & other persons with allegation that they were cheated by Rajat Gupta as well as Dr. Kaleshwar Prasad Singh for facilitating admission in MBBS course at KGMU. Ms. Madhu Jyoti has also lodged a FIR No.600/14 U/s 406, 419, 420, 467, 468, 471. Dr. Kaleshwar Prasad Singh was arrested on 24.11.2014 and was in jail between 25.11.2014 to 24.02.2017. Dr. Kaleshwar Prasad Singh was placed under suspension and a Disciplinary Committee was constituted to enquire the allegations against him. A charge sheet was served upon Dr. Kaleshwar Prasad Singh and enquiry was conducted. After due enquiry and with the approval of the Executive Council Dr. Kaleshwar Prasad Singh was dismissed from service vide office order No. VC/KGMU/2019/72 dated 04.11.2019.	arguing the case before the Hon'ble Court.
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Dr. Kaleshwar Prasad Singh filed a writ petition Writ-A No. 5845 of 2020, Dr. Kaleshwar Prasad Singh vs. King George's Medical University, Lucknow through Registrar and Another before the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Allahabad, Lucknow Bench challenging the order of dismissal. Hon'ble High Court heard the parties and finally decided the writ petition on 15.07.2026. Operative portion of the order is as under:

“Considering the submissions of the parties and going through the contents of the petition, the relevant record of disciplinary proceeding as well as other relevant materials, the record reveals that the disciplinary proceeding was initiated on the basis of fact-finding inquiry. The petitioner was placed under suspension and charge-sheet was issued, then reply was given asking fact finding report for proper reply, but the same was not given. The statements of witnesses were recorded in absence of petitioner, then he requested to give opportunity for cross examination of witnesses. The record also reveals that the committee accepted the request of the petitioner for cross-examination, summoning the witnesses, who were produced before the Department. Thereafter, summons were also issued to the witnesses, but they did not turn up. The inquiry committee also observed that

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the petitioner failed to make efforts for ensuring the presence of the witnesses.

It is an undisputed fact that after examining the witnesses by the Department, they were called for cross-examination, but they did not turn up for cross-examination. It is well settled that opportunity for cross-examination of witnesses is a right of the delinquent employee, but it was not given by saying that the petitioner failed to make efforts for ensuring the presence of the witnesses, therefore, the inquiry is not in accordance with law.

With the above observations, the writ petition is allowed. The impugned punishment order dated 04.11.2019 is hereby set aside and the matter is remitted back to the Inquiry Committee to provide the copy of the fact-finding inquiry report and facilitate cross-examining the witnesses and also ensure that the inquiry be concluded within a period of three months from the date of production of certified copy of this order. The disciplinary authority is further directed to pass the final order in accordance with law within one month thereafter.

Let the original record of the disciplinary authority be handed over to the learned counsel for K.G.M.U. forthwith.

There shall be no orders as to costs.”

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	Dr. Kaleshwar Prasad Singh submitted a representation dated 18.07.2026 with a request for compliance of the judgment dated 15.07.2026. Executive Council was requested to deliberate on the order passed by Hon'ble High Court and take further decision in the matter.
