

HPV Vaccination camp

Cancer cervix is the 2nd most common cancer in women in India though the 4th most common in the world. We need to work hard to reduce its incidence in our country as it is a cancer which can be prevented primarily by HPV vaccination and secondarily by regular screening. So today in a first step in the direction Dept of Obs and Gyn KGMU in collaboration with inner wheel club members organized a free vaccination camp for young girls. The program was inaugurated by hon'ble VC ma'am who is very committed to cancer cervix vaccination and she has supported us in our endeavor. In addition a CBC was done for these girls free of cost to further help fight problem of anaemia in these girls. Total of 100 girls were vaccinated
