Respected Sir,

Following is the SOP for Applicants wishing to visit Foreign Universities through IC Cell King George's Medical University U.P., Lucknow.

- The candidate must secure an aggregate percentage of all MBBS/ BDS professionals not less than 65%.
- Applicant must show keen interest/ability in the subject of choice through concrete evidence of participation, presentation, certification or performance.
- A 300 word essay should be submitted to the International Collaboration (IC) Cell clearly mentioning why the applicant should be selected for the international exchange.
- The applicant may have to give a screening examination.
- All mails correspondence to the International University need to be channelled through the International Collaboration Cell. Applicant must ensure that all forms & recommendations are signed by the competent authority.
- All formalities and requirements of the host Institution should be scrupulously completed.
- All benefits accruing from the Observership/Scholarship should be duly communicated to the IC Cell
