Phase I Training

- The objective of training is to strengthening preventive oncology at primary health level.
- This training was conducted in collaboration with NHM, William J. Clinton Foundation (WJCF), an affiliate of the Clinton Health Access Initiative (CHAI) and Dept of Obs & Gyn, KGMU, Lucknow has initiated the program to expand access to quality cancer care in UP.

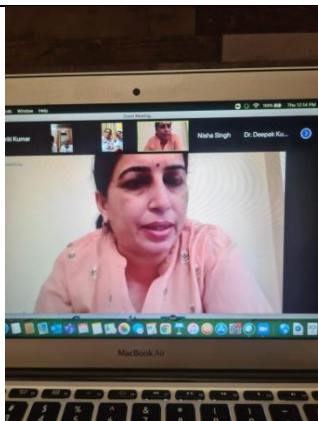

Phase III Training

- The objective of PPH Emergency Care training is to improve the quality of PPH emergency care at facilities that perform deliveries.
- While the goal is to strengthen the PPH emergency response in order to decrease maternal morbidity and mortality, integral to the program is the understanding that strengthening a clinical response requires more than training providers on clinical skills.
- It is a three days training.
- 2 Day online & 1 day in person training of "PPH Emergency response care using a Bundle approach" was conducted in the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology for doctors from five peripheral hospitals/facilities.
- We have completed total 4 batches
- Total 100 Participants were trained in 4 batches on the following dates
 - 25th -27th Aug 2021 – Batch I
 - 1st -3rd Sep 2021 – Batch II
 - 7th, 8th & 10th Sep 2021 – Batch III
 - 13th -15th Sep 2021 – Batch IV
