OFFICE ORDER

A PIL No.1012 of 2023 Jyoti Rajpoot versus State of U.P. and others was filed before the Hon'ble High Court of Allahabad, Lucknow. Hon'ble High Court on 07.11.2023 issued directions to State Government to place before it the scheme framed by the State Government in consultation with the Department of Social Welfare regarding the treatment of the unattended/abandoned patients, identification of places for treatment of unattended/abandoned patients or if the State Government has made any other mechanism provided for the treatment of such patients in the State Government Hospitals.

In pursuance to the orders of the Hon'ble High Court, Government of U.P., Medical Education Section – 2, vide order No.1/702614/2024/71-2099/11/2024 dated 26.07.2024 and order No.1/722081/2024/71-2099/11/2024 dated 21.08.2024 issued necessary directions for the treatment of destitute/unattended/abandoned patients in the Government hospitals in the State of Uttar Pradesh.

In compliance of the orders of the Hon'ble High Court and Government of U.P. a committee, consisting of the following, was constituted by the KGMU, Lucknow, vide office order No. KGMUVC/101/2024 dated September 06, 2024 to deliberate on the matter of treatment of destitute/unattended/abandoned patients in KGMU, Lucknow and submit its recommendations prescribing the guidelines to be followed by the University for treatment of such patients:

Committee held its meeting on 09.09.2024 and 17.09.2024 and after due deliberations submitted the following recommendations:

1. Treatment of the Destitute: Destitute will be brought to the Casualty of Trauma Center, KGMU for the treatment, where he/she will be registered and his/her treatment will be started as per the department concerned and this patient information will be given to the Nodal/Coordinator/MSSO's for free treatment.
2. A designate Destitute Ward with 10 beds would be established in the Drug Addiction Centre, under the Department of Psychiatry, in front of Trauma Centre.
3. From the point of view of treatment of destitute one bed should be made available in each medical and surgical ward with one attendant and one Safai Karamchhari (e.g. one in Neurosurgery, one in Cardiology, one in Trauma Surgery, one in Medicine, one in General Surgery, one in Psychiatry, one in Queen Mary Hospital, one in Pediatrics and one in Orthopedic surgery).
4. Mr. Akhilesh Tripathi, CMSSO is being nominated as Nodal Officer for the free treatment of destitute/abandoned patients under the Medical Superintendent of the area.
5. A register will be maintained in each department for the destitute patient and it is necessary to mention and register the destitute patients on e-hospital with his/her UHID.
6. The destitute patient will be discharged or transferred to Destitute Ward when the Head of the Department agrees. HODs will ensure that his/her treatment will be free of cost.
7. MSSO will coordinate with the doctor on duty for the treatment of the patient and deposit the virtual money in the ID of the destitute patient and will also provide all possible help in his/her treatment.
8. The destitute patient will be kept in the ward reserved for the destitute until the patient recovers. After the patient recovers, the destitute patient will be transferred in the ward reserved for the destitute and he will be kept until the patient recovers. After the patient recovers following steps will be taken:
 - a) In case of **Mentally Fit patients**, the patient will be sent to Old Age Homes run by Social Welfare Department in coordination with District Social Welfare Officer.
 - b) In case of **Mentally Ill patients**, the patient will be sent to District Mental Hospital in coordination with the concerned District Magistrate.

- c) In case of **Mentally ill patient with non-curable illness** the patient will be sent to Mansik Mandit Griha run by the Department of Empowerment of Person with Disabilities in coordination with District Empowerment Officer for Persons with Disabilities.
9. If a destitute patient is found in the premises or left by the attendants, the Information should be forwarded to the Trauma Centre Police Chowki by MSSO's and also responsibility of the personnel should be fixed for admission/registration for the destitute in the Trauma Emergency of Medical University/respective departments.
10. Anyone who has no family member/care taker with him/her will be considered "Destitute" even if he/she is able to tell his/her name and/or address.
11. The primary clinical team which first treated the patient will also look after the care of patient in destitute ward.
12. After treatment of the patient, at the time of discharge, the treating resident/consultant will submit the complete detail of expenditure on treatment of the patient to the office of Medical Superintendent/ Chief Medical Superintendent, so that re-imbursement of expenses may made from the Government Grant, through Finance Officer.

The above arrangements will come into force with immediate effect and to be ensured by all the concerned officers/officials for the proper treatment of destitute/abandoned/unattended patients at the KGMU, Lucknow.
