Dear Sir/Madam,

We have received a complaint of ragging from a student of KING GEORGE MEDICAL UNIVERSITY. The details are given below.

You are requested to identify & counsel the victim so that he feels safe and knows that authorities are with him & action will be taken on his complaint. You are also requested not to disclose the identity of the victim.

*7.1 action to be taken by the head of the institution by the order of hon. Supreme court:

On receipt of any information concerningAny reported incident of ragging, the head of institution shall immediately determine if a case under the penal laws is made out and if so, proceed to file a first information report (fir), within twenty four hours of receipt of such information or recommendation, with the police and local authorities, under the appropriate penal provisions relating to one or more of the following, namely:

- V. Violation of decency and morals through ragging;
- VI. Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt;
- X. Assault as well as sexual offences or unnatural offences;
- XI. Extortion;
- Xvii. Physical or psychological humiliation;

Note: Enquiry /investigation /disciplinary committee reports etc. Are not acceptable. As per ugc regulations only report of the anti-ragging committee is acceptable.

MINUTES OF THE MEETING


